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PAYMENTS, PERMITS & NOTES:

- 1. Organizations will provide their own tents, tables, and chairs to fit in a 12'x12' space. Items left overnight are the responsibility of your organization.
- 2. No active selling (of any product) is allowed other than by pre-registered, non-profit organizations; however, items may be displayed, appointments scheduled, mailing list formed, etc.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the booth selling food/drink to obtain a permit from the North Central District Health Department: 860-745-0383.
- 4. Electricity can only be run to certain locations. For each plug requested, an exterior-rated 100 ft extension cord is required and all cords need to be covered to prevent anyone from tripping over electrical cords.
- 5. Carnival games require Suffield Police Department approval: 860-668-3870.
- 6. Event occurs rain or shine, no refunds.
- 7. Applications received after August 1, 2018 will be assessed a \$20.00 late fee
- 8. Returned checks will be charged a \$20.00 administrative fee + all bank charges.
- 9. You must pay a minimum of \$10 for any booth deemed for electricity even if you do not plan on using the electricity.
- 10. There is a \$20 cancellation fee for an accepted organization that withdraws from the event after July 1st. No refund after event is full.
